

**SCENIC CELLARS CHARITY TRIATHLON,
WHAREWAKA POINT, 22nd February-10**



The annual Scenic Cellars sponsored charity triathlon was held at Wharewaka Point on Monday night. The TriSport Taupo organised event was over a 200m swim, 12.7km bike and a 3.0km run course. The event attracted a field of 86 individuals and teams. First home was senior James McGrogan in 35m48s in the 20-39 age group followed by Junior (15-19) Alex Roberts in 37m34s with Bryce Giddy in 3rd place and the first 40-54 veteran in 38m19s. The first under 15 junior boy was Aidan Hawkins in 43m03s with Steve Currie the first 55+ veteran in 41m26s. The first woman home in 10th place overall was outstanding under 15 junior Nicole VanderKaay in 41m52s. The first 15-19 junior was Ellie Heenan in 45m06, the first senior woman was Tracey Allan in 43m15s with Debi Woodward the first 40-54 veteran in 45m12s. The first of 8 corporate teams and winner of the inaugural Contact Corporate Challenge cup was “The Police” team of Steve Dunn, Dean Barnes and Shane Brookes in a time of 39m15s. The first of the 10 non corporate teams was the Aaron, Tori and Stutz team in 41m03s.

There were many Scenic Cellars spot prize winners with around half of competitors receiving a prize. The \$560 raised on the night by Tri Sport Taupo and Scenic Cellars will be donated to the “**SADD Students Against Driving Drunk**” group. Senior students from both colleges addressed the competitors on SADD’s goals and objectives before the race.

The next TriSport Taupo event on Monday 1st Mar. is the annual pre Ironman Splash & Dash starting from the yacht club at 6pm. This event for individuals or teams is a 500m swim followed by a 5km run along the lake front. A small entry fee will be charged.
