- Entry Fee:** \$20.00 payable with entry. (\$30.00 for all entries received after 18th May 2010)

Equipment:

- Approved hard shell helmets must be worn and they must be in sound condition.
- All bikes must be roadworthy. Unsafe bikes will not be allowed to start. Get them checked.
- No composite wheels, minimum 16 spokes, no aero bars.

Gearing:

Intermediate Schools Students

: Year 7-8 must have 6.000 metre roll out (no exceptions) Get your bike checked at your bike store.

Secondary Schools Students

: U15 Secondary schools riders must have 6.00 metre roll out (no exceptions)
: U17 riders 6.61 metres
: U19 riders 7.93 metres

Race Numbers

- Numbers will be issued at registration and must be worn.

GENERAL

- Registration is from 8.30am – 10.00am only.
- Roll out checks will take place prior to racing. The first 5 place getters will be re-checked immediately at the conclusion of each event.
- The award ceremony will be in the Hall at the conclusion of all racing – approx 1.30pm.
- Racing is under Bike NZ and NZSCA rules (due to the high percentage of Waikato BOP cyclists who belong to BikeNZ Clubs, we choose to use the BikeNZ rules regarding gear restrictions, not those of the NZSCA).
- Entries close Tuesday 18th of May 2010. Late entries, if accepted will incur a cost of \$10/individual.
- Entries must be made on the attached entry form.
